Here is a checklist of dos and don'ts for men:

- Make sure all garments are clean and well pressed
- Wear a long sleeved shirt in a light solid colour or conservative stripes
- When choosing a tie avoid fashion extremes; no character ties, if you have a plain shirt go for a striped tie and vice versa
- Ties should reach the top of the waistband and not be longer or shorter.
- Wear dark socks, mid calf length so no skin is visible when you sit down
- Wear black leather lace-up or slip on business shoes.

- If you have facial hair make sure it is well groomed
