## Training and Staff Development

All organisations require professional training for their staff. This is often difficult to achieve because:

- Your organisation does not possess the necessary training knowledge or skills.
- You do not have the resources to dedicate to staff training.
- Packaged training does not cater for the particular characteristics of your organisation or the content required.

The School of Computing and Mathematical Sciences at LJMU can provide cost effective training either on-site at your organisation or at our own purpose built commercial training centre. This training centre is situated in central Liverpool on our Byrom Street site and can cater for courses for 3 to 120 people.

The delivery of courses can be adapted to suit the needs of your organisation. Flexible options allow the delivery of courses either during the day or the evening and they can be delivered in a block, for example over a working week, or spread over a number of weeks either for example to suit flexible day release. Day time courses at our training centre include refreshments and a buffet lunch. Evening courses include refreshments.

## Short Courses

We have an up-to-date portfolio of courses in Computing and ICT that can be delivered in short blocks (for example 1-5 days). This form of training is best suited where your organisation can release staff from their day-to-day job for the period involved.
