Holiday camps

Child minders

Childminders can be booked individually by parents by contacting a childminder in the local area. Liverpool Council has a list of registered childminders

Event nannies and babysitters

These are available through local providers such as Bluey and Baloo (<http://www.blueyandbaloo.co.uk>). Nannies are a great option for small groups of less than 8, The ratio of nannies to children will be based on NSPCC's adult to child ratios. The cost is £35.00 per nanny per hour and includes a small selection of activities and toys. They ask for a minimum of 2 hours.

Bluey and Baloo can also provide babysitting (evening), the cost is £19.50 per hour. This service is usually directly booked by parents.
