The purpose of this study was to explore how men storied their journeys to developing and maintaining a high drive for muscle

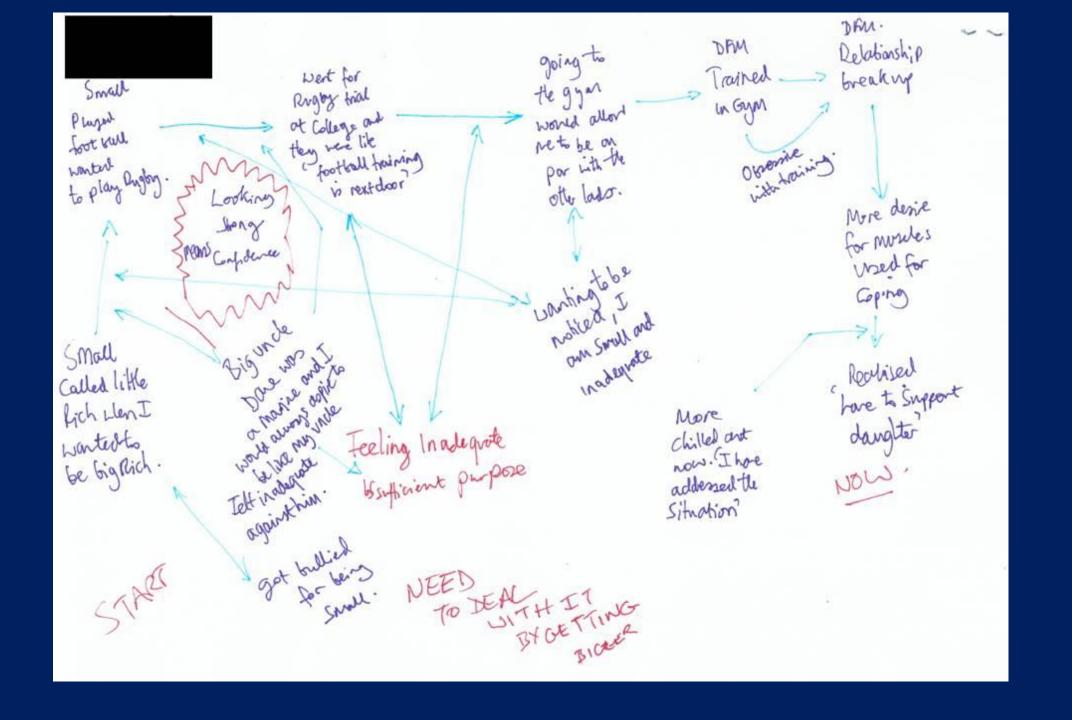
Participants

athletes (rugby)



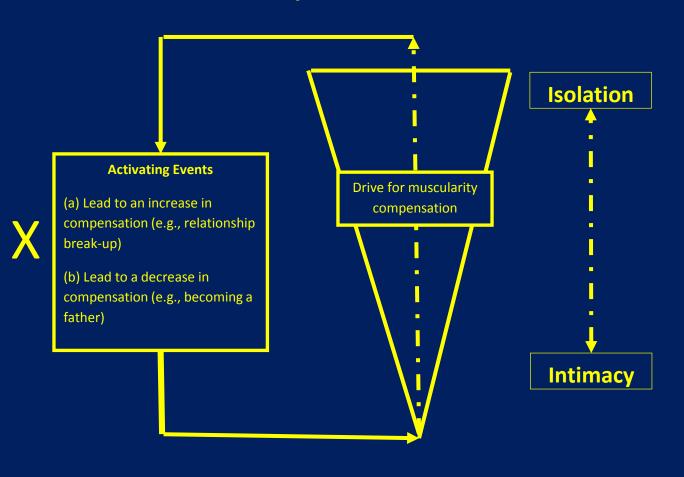


Master Narrative
