


Passport

Passport is a global market research database providing insight on industries, economies and consumers worldwide.

This database is available on and off campus and may be accessed from **Databases** in the **Electronic Library** at: www.ljmu.ac.uk/library/e-library

- From the Electronic Library web page select the **Databases** option or alternatively from the library search tool **Discover**,  select **Databases** at the top of the screen
- Click on **Sign in** in the top right hand corner and if prompted login with your **LJMU username@ljmu.ac.uk** and **password**
- Once signed in you then need to type in **Passport** into the search box and click on the **search icon**
- Click on **Passport** from the results list and then the online link in the **View Online** box

Searching

You can perform a search to find most relevant statistics and analysis by entering your search term(s) in the search box and selecting the search icon:

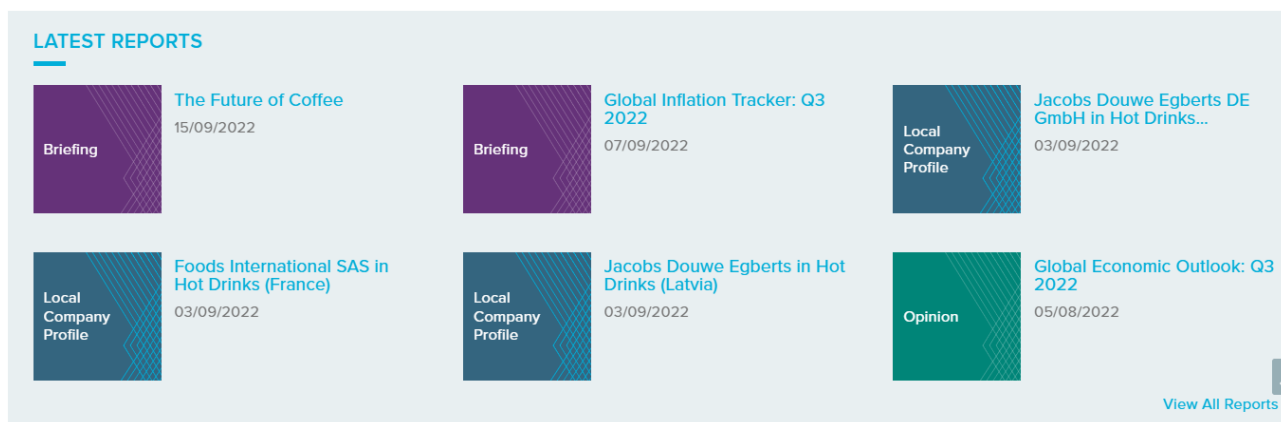
Next choose a sector for example Drinks by selecting the button:
