Getting Started

From the Electronic Library page (<u>www.ljmu.ac.uk/library/e-library</u>) click on **Databases A-Z**, then on W to find **Westlaw International** in the list.

Links to European Union materials are provided within Westlaw UK and within Westlaw International. The international section contains all jurisdictions available on Westlaw except for UK and US jurisdictions.

This guide covers the International and the US sections of Westlaw and where to find EU material on Westlaw UK.
