- One-to one support to students in the form of drop-ins and bookable appointments (face-to-face, online and telephone)
- Academic skills consultancy service for academic staff
- Design and dissemination of diverse and inclusive learning and teaching materials
- Maths and Statistics advice 'Drop In' service
- Library inductions
- Programme of structured and bespoke Library sessions including: advanced literature searching and referencing
