Paul McCartney: Many Years From Now

Research Archive and a Beatles Reference Archive

#### The Archive:

This is one of the largest research libraries on the Beatles in existence, designed as a writer's reference library rather than as a fan's collection. It was assembled to gather together and organise information on the Beatles and was used to write dozens of articles and a number of books, the most important of which was the authorised biography: Paul McCartney: Many Years From Now. Information is organised on a year-by-year basis and sometimes by subject within each year. This is a format which can be easily added to and extended into the future. The archive also includes the working drafts of Paul McCartney: Many Years From Now, including early drafts with material that was later edited out, sometimes at McCartney's request.

The collection comprises approx 3,750 pages of clippings and tearsheets, plus over 500 complete magazines; almost 100 newspapers and specials published at the time of John Lennon's death; more than 125 books; more than 30 bootleg CDs including the nine volume <u>Beatles at BBC</u> complete; 42 cassette interview tapes with McCartney by Miles plus 25 others including interviews with George Harrison (1967) and John Lennon (1969); over 1,800 pages of interview transcripts; more than 3,000 pages of notes, early drafts and draft mss.

This archive contains ample material for many PhD studies on the Beatles and would make an ideal core upon which to build a research library on their work and on British popular music studies in general.

## **Barry Miles:**

"I first interviewed Paul McCartney for International Times in December 1966 and this tape, along with its transcript, is the earliest recording in the archive. In the late sixties I worked for the Beatles' Apple Records as the label manager for their Zapple experimental series, and some of the items included here were first acquired at that time, such as the scarce Apple in-house magazines. Over the years I wrote extensively about the Beatles in magazines like Crawdaddy, Oz, International Times, NME, High Times, The Observer, Q, Mojo, and many more obscure titles including American underground newspapers like the San Francisco Oracle. In the course of researching my biography of Paul McCartney I had all of his relevant archives shipped over to my flat, six boxes at time, and I made photocopies of everything that looked of the slightest interest. Many of the news items were wire-service stories reprinted in scores of newspapers. Of these I only kept one example. I had permission to keep the originals of any duplicates from press cuttings agencies, of which there were many. Thus several thousands of the clippings and photocopies in this archive originated in Paul McCartney's own archive which, particularly in the case of American newspapers, proved invaluable as they would have been almost impossible to track down. The collection also includes within it sufficient visual material to mount a number of exhibitions."
