Why have I been asked to take part?

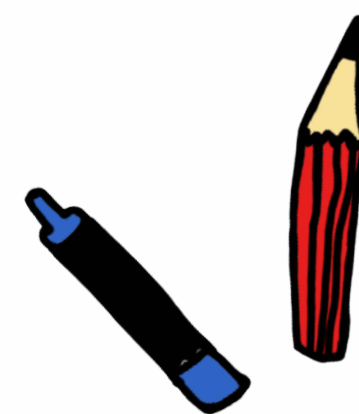
