

## 6.6 Public Transport Journey Apps

Public transport is very important in providing links between a skilled workforce and the workplace, whilst also enhancing opportunities to establish and maintain new contacts, work in partnership and access new markets. Furthermore, it is vital to the student population who are based across the Liverpool City Region to access the University for education and extra-curricular activities (see 7. Campus Assessment).
